Irish grain legume collection ?!



- Grain legumes national collections: collections hold by universities (e.g. pea collection @ UCD), Seed Savers Association (community/members seed multiplication), Teagasc (faba beans: pre-breeding lines/ ProFaba panel)
- The most focused grain legumes species: faba beans, peas and lupins
- The availability of phenotypic and genotypic data: Partial
- Seeds availability for sharing based on SMTA: Unknown



Expectations from EVA legumes



- EVA Legumes network from researchers' perspective (material, traits, conditions of operation): Expectations Potential to assess legumes' material with interesting traits; Constraints: Maintenance of seed collections.
- Interest and capacity to be involved in evaluation of different GL species: Cool-season grain legumes (food & feed)
- Ways to cooperate/experience with PPP: Multiply seed; phenotype under field conditions; controlled environment studies
