

Terms of Reference of the EURISCO Advisory Committee

Endorsed by ECPGR Steering Committee - June 2023

A **EURISCO Advisory Committee** is established to monitor the progress of EURISCO and give advice on its further development. Members of the Committee and its Chair are selected under their personal capacity by the ECPGR ExCo, based on suggestions received from the Chair of the Doc&Info WG and ECPGR SC members. The Chair of the Doc&Info WG is a member of the EURISCO Advisory Committee and can also be designated as its Chair. The ECPGR Secretariat will support the organization of meetings. The Committee aims at face-to-face meetings at least every two years, but more frequent interactions can be scheduled in the form of videoconferences.

The Chair of the EURISCO Advisory Committee has the following responsibilities:

- Propose meetings of the Committee (physical or virtual) and draft the agendas of the meeting
- Chair the meetings of the Committee and approve meeting reports
- Approve the reports and work plans that are prepared annually by the EURISCO Coordinator, after receiving feedback from the EURISCO Advisory Committee and the ECPGR Secretary
- Keep regular contact with the WGs and coordinate the activities of the Committee in support of the EURISCO Coordinator.
