

Terms of Reference of the EURISCO Advisory Committee Endorsed by ECPGR Steering Committee - April 2021

The EURISCO Advisory Committee is established to monitor the progress of EURISCO and give advice on its further development. Members of the Committee and its Chair are selected under their personal capacity by the ECPGR Executive Committee, based on suggestions received from the Chair of the Doc&Info WG and from ECPGR Steering Committee members. The Chair of the Doc&Info WG is a member of the EURISCO Advisory Committee and can also be designated as its Chair. The ECPGR Secretary participates *ex officio* in the activities of the Committee, supporting the organization of its meetings, finalizing the agenda and drafting the meeting's reports. The Committee aims at face-to-face meetings at least every two years, but more frequent interactions can be scheduled in the form of video-conferences.

The Chair of the EURISCO Advisory Committee undertakes the following functions:

- 1) Propose meetings of the Committee (physical or virtual) and draft the meetings' agendas
- 2) Chair the meetings of the Committee and approves meetings' reports
- 3) Approve the reports and workplans prepared annually by the EURISCO Coordinator, after receiving feedback from the EURISCO Advisory Committee and the ECPGR Secretary.
