Aims of the AEGIS project:

- to ensure ex situ long-term conservation of crop genetic resources in Europe
- to ensure their easy access
- to ensure their continued use
- to avoid duplication of conservation efforts in Europe
- to **share** conservation efforts in general within Europe

The project (2004-2006) is funded by ECP/GR and involves technical experts from the major genebanks in Europe. Project partners are expected to assess the current conservation status of four model crops (Allium, Avena, Brassica and Prunus) in Europe and propose specific solutions for an integrated genebank system.

The output of this feasibility study is expected to consist of a set of recommendations based on the analysis of organizational, structural, technical, legal and financial aspects, for endorsement by the ECP/GR Steering Committee and further implementation in Europe.
