- AEGIS: **ECPGR initiative** aiming to efficiently **conserve** and provide **access** to unique **germplasm** in Europe through the establishment of <u>the European Collection</u>.
- European governments can become AEGIS members.
- Agreed quality standards in the Associate Member genebank/institutions.
- (SMTA) set out by the FAO International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture.











Objectives

- Efficiently **conserve** and provide **access** to unique germplasm in Europe through AEGIS and the European Collection.
- Provide passport and phenotypic information of actively conserved European PGRFA diversity ex situ and in situ through the EURISCO catalogue.
- Improve in situ conservation and use of crop wild relatives.
- Promote on-farm conservation.
- Promote use of PGRFA.



 € 540 000 per year).
- National Coordinators are nominated at governmental level.
- Use of funds:
 - Coordination
 - Working Group activities
 - Maintenance of EURISCO


AEGIS and the Treaty

- AEGIS uses the Treaty's mechanisms, procedures and instruments, and Standard Material Transfer Agreement (SMTA).







Total European Accessions: 70830





